Hello Members, well my favorite season is here “Summer” and hopefully we will all have a great summer by staying healthy.

We are officially open in the pavilion and will continue to stay open 7 days a week starting at 12:00 noon, Blue Collar is open from 12noon- 8:00 every day except on Fridays open to 9:00 pm, food will still be available at the bar which is personal pan pizza. If everyone follows the guidelines given to us by the state of NJ I believe we can continue to be open all summer. You must wear a mask when ordering food or a beverage in the pavilion and using the restrooms. Please use the hand sanitizer available at the bar. We have seating inside the pavilion up to 50 people and a Tent with high top tables in the Parking Lot and outside near the firepit we provided picnic tables for Lunch/Dinner , part of the guideline line is no smoking near people eating food, so please ,No smoking in pavilion and surrounding areas, a designated area is under the tin canopy near the barbeques. Always bring your membership card and a mask.

Summer Hours for Lodge Meetings: One Meeting per month which will be on July 28th @7:30 in the Pavilion, last call for dinner will be 6:45 pm and last call for your beverage is 7:15 , meeting begins at 7:30. We are still not allowed inside the building per the NJ Governor’s guidelines. Please bring your mask.

Lodge Leagues: Shuffleboard, Darts, Horseshoes, Bocce ball must be an Elk Member. No exceptions.

As we continue to enjoy the areas surrounding the marina, we have received complaints from boaters that some of the picnic areas are being used by non-boaters who may also be Elks and their guests. We urge all members to be respectful of one another and share the tables and tin canopy's together. When you leave the area, please remove all trash and personal belongings being mindful of someone may want to use that area after you. There are dumpsters on the property to take your trash.

Docks: We recently put a berm along the parking lot to prevent future flood damage in the dock area. We had three walkways installed for the boaters to get to their boats with ease which is not fully completed. Solar lights have been installed to assist you in the evening hours. We ask that you do not walk on the berm itself. Additionally, please refrain from parking directly in front of these walkways for the safety of our boaters.

Please clean up after yourself, safety first——please throw all garbage in cans provided and cigarette butts in proper receptacles. We have ample parking spaces around the lodge, there should be no reason to park on the grass. Lastly we have installed solar lights in the tent and surrounding the tents area for your safety.

Boaters, Paperwork such as, Insurance, Registration and Current Elks card needs to be current. If it's not please mail in your updated copies now. Reminder on Dock Boxes, It's your responsibility as a slip holder to lock the dock box lid in place. Our dock crew has been finding lids blown open that had not been locked. If the lid is blown off, the box will be removed and new dock box will be at the slip holder's expense.

ONBOARD AIRCONDITIONERS, are not to be on unless you are on the Elks property. Hose lines connected to hose valves, numerous are found to be left on each week. When finished with your hose please shut your hose line off. The loss of water due to this has contributed to running up our water bill possibly leading to a slip fee increase. Please conserve. Electric Cords, Water Hose, and dock lines need to be secured at your slip in its proper place and not left on the docks to become a tripping hazard. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated in maintaining a safe marina for all.
